### **Pitching Instructions- Dining Shelter**

Open bag, lay out all the parts & make up the poles- You should have:

#### 1 x Canvas sheet

# 1 x Steel ridge pole, 2 x Steel uprights, 4 x Steel corner poles 2 x Main guys, with dollies & a selection of pegs

#### It is best to have 3 people to pitch this dining shelter.

- 1. Lay out the canvas sheet
- 2. Slip in the ridge pole, lining up the holes in the ends with the eyelets at either end of the canvas sheet
- 3. Position each of the long uprights and enter the spikes into the end of the ridge pole, then through the canvas eyelet
- 4. Slip each of the main guys over the end spikes of the uprights (now protruding from the canvas uprights)
- 5. With one person holding each long uprights, pull the shelter up into the vertical position.
- 6. The 3<sup>rd</sup> person should now peg out the main guy lines, then both sides (4 guys) should be pegged out, stabilising the shelter
- 7. Insert each of the 4 smaller (corner) uprights
- 8. Peg out each of the corner and side guy lines
- 9. Now, go round your shelter, "tensioning / trimming" each of the guy lines to make sure it is stable, taught and square.
